Individuals searching for lost connections or answers to unanswered questions about their past.

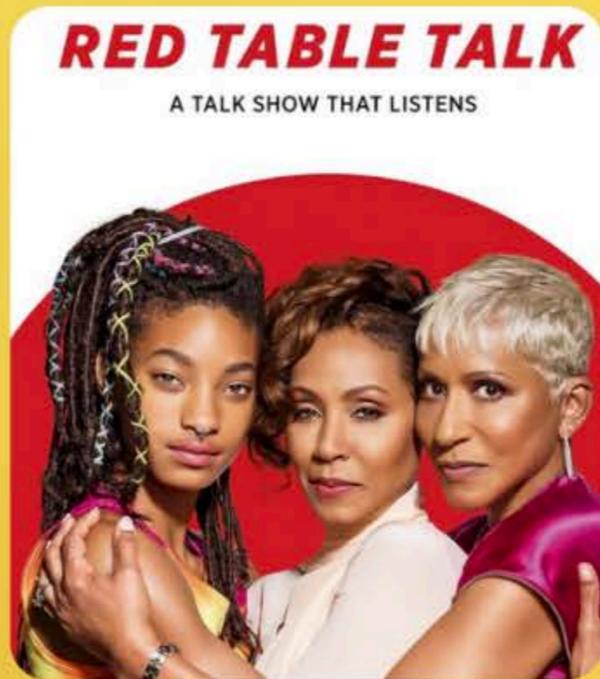
